## Term 1

### General Studies

#### Math

- Number Sense - Counting forward and backward to 30, number sequencing, printing and recognizing numbers pictorially and numerically
- Graphing- interpreting bar graphs and tally marks
- Shapes- Two and three dimensional
- Patterns - Exploring patterns using colours, shapes and letters

#### English Language Arts

- Upper and Lowercase letter exposure - name of letters and their sounds
- Printing name independently
- Learning how to print from left to right and formation of letters and numbers from top to bottom

#### Science

- Exploration of trees and how they change with the seasons
- Exploring colours and their variations

#### Social Studies

- Learning about Peace and the poppy for Remembrance Day
- Celebrating Star of the Week/All About Me - exploring our unique qualities
- Learning the days of the week, months of the year
