- improves attention and focus during learning time.



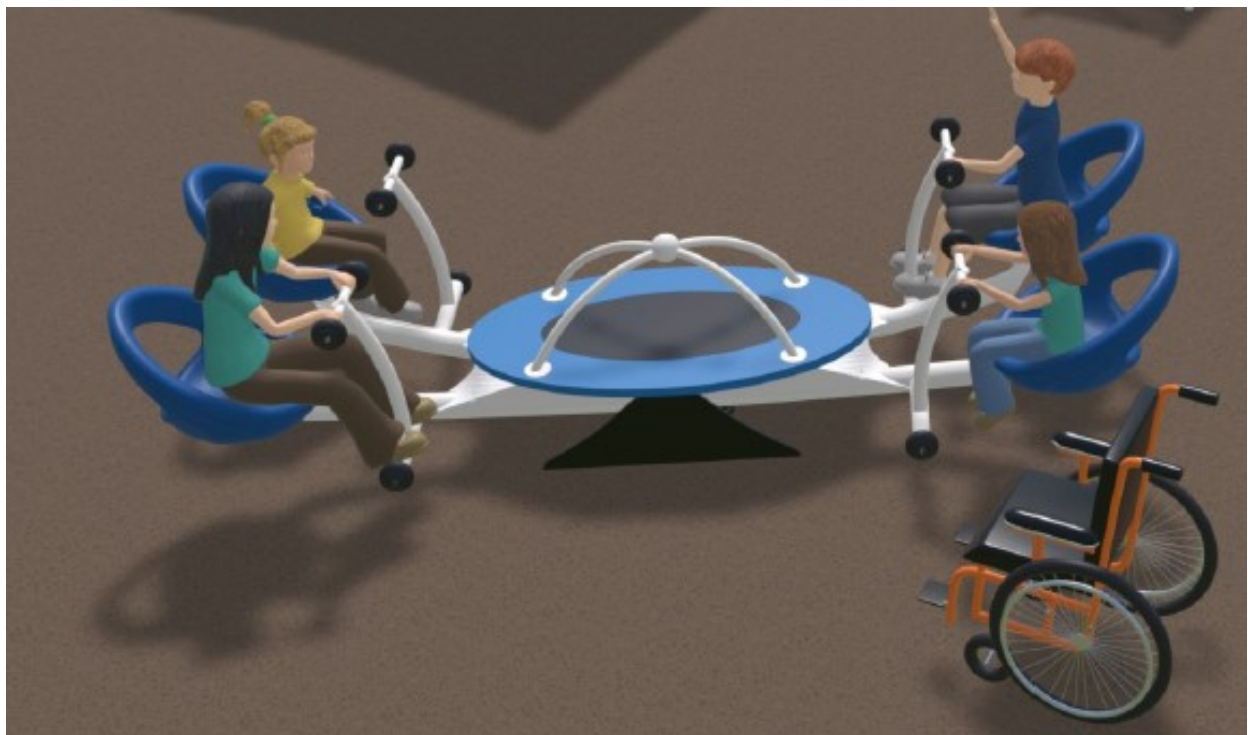
AN INCLUSIVE PLAYGROUND

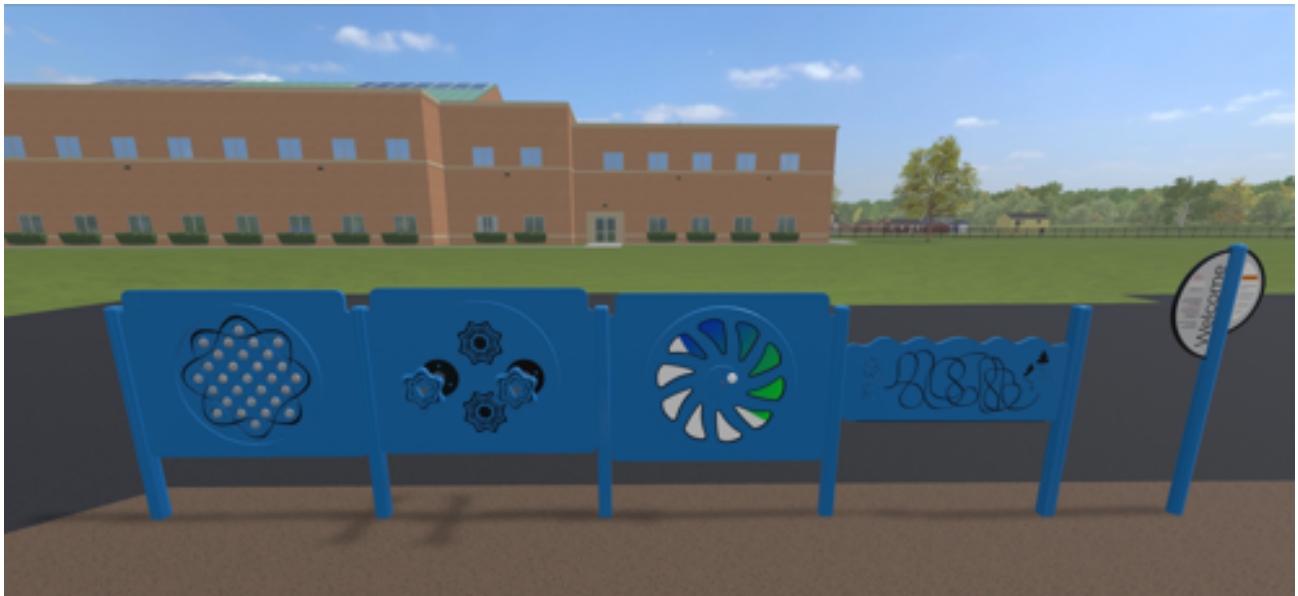


MULTI-SENSORY PLAY

All children need opportunities to develop their senses. Sensory play panels help children enhance their cognitive, tactile, sensory, motor, social/emotional and language skills, independently and with friends.

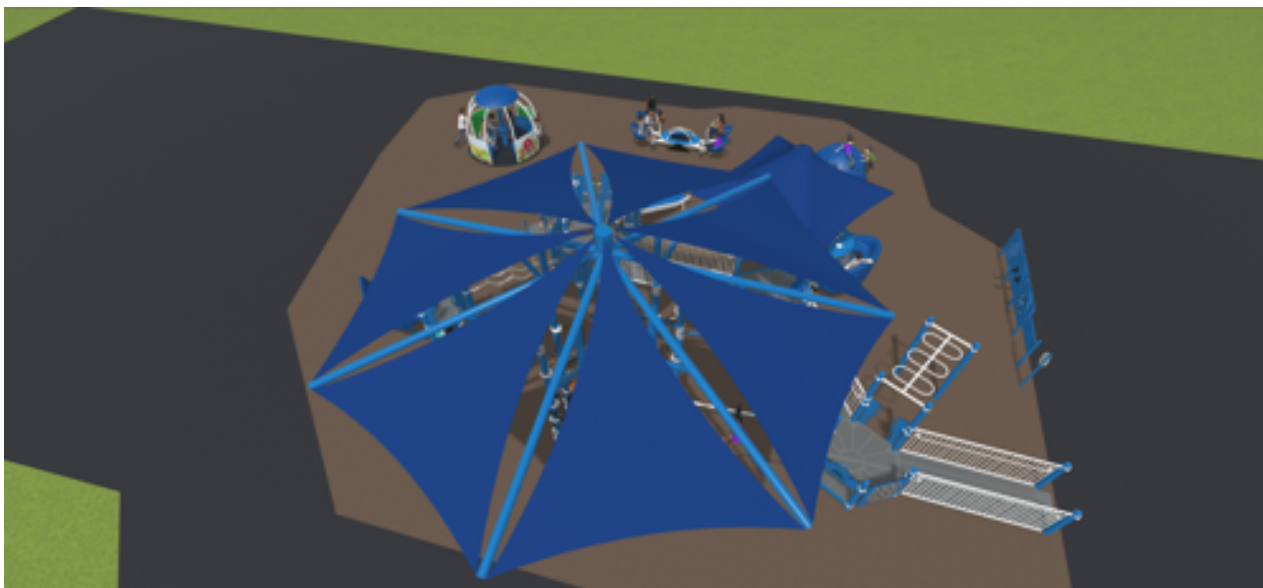
